Notes:

- Some of your exams will run over break, particularly if you have extra time in exams, so you may prefer to bring snacks and lunch from home on those days
- Due to the change in specification, many of the afternoon exams will result in a longer school day. Please make sure you are aware of your finishing time and plan on how you are getting home
- Venue and seating plans will be put up in the Sixth Form Centre the day before each exam; please check it
- If you miss an examination, you will be expected to complete it as soon as possible after you have returned to school

And some general exam reminders:

- Bring your black pens and any other equipment you will need, in a clear case or plastic bag. We are not able to loan you any equipment, so please make sure you have spares.
- Make sure you do not have your mobile phone or any other electronic device with you.
- No watches may be worn during an exam. If you wear a watch, please leave it at home on exam day. We have many clocks available for you to monitor your exam timings.
- If you are allowed a calculator in the exam, do not bring its cover, and clear any memory.
- Students in Sixth Form are allowed to wear foam or plastic earplugs to aid concentration if they wish but they must tell the invigilator at each exam.
- If you are taking a bottle of water in, take off the label.
- The exams department is not allowed to add information to the front of your answer booklets, so please be sure to complete the front page completely and accurately according to the instructions from your invigilator.
