



Extra-curricular clubs







What will I be doing at this group?:


- Following the 12 week Rainbows Bereavement Support programme to help support with loss or bereavement


Club: Chess (Years 7-13)




Club: Creative Writing (Years 7-13)



What will I be doing at this club?:


- Using different prompts and games to create storylines and characters

What will I be doing at this club?:


- Learning about some of the most deadly species on our planet.

What will I be doing at this club?:


- Working in teams exploring and creating different arguments for and against viewpoints on ethical dilemmas, current issues in society and the big theological and philosophical questions of the world.




Club: Food Club (Year 9 - sign up only)



What will I be doing at this club?:


- Cooking a range of recipes to help you develop skills & knowledge in cooking

What will I be doing at this club?:




Club: Media Club (Years 10-11)




What will I be doing at this club?:







What will I be doing at this club?


Club: Rocket Club (Years 10 and 12)


Club: Sew What?! Textiles Club (Years 8,9,10)




Club: Spanish GCSE Club (Years 9-10 – native speakers)






Club: Spanish Film Club (Years 12-13)




Sports clubs

Cancellations – students must check the school noticeboards for last minute cancellations



Club: Warhammer Club (Years 7-13)




What will I be doing at this club?:
