

School Masterplan

In 2022 St Peter's School commissioned Lytle Associates Architects to consider a long term estate masterplan for the whole school site. Consultation with key stakeholders including staff, students and governors identified sport and drama as two priority areas for development.

Sport


- Improved capacity for outdoor sport during the winter
- All weather floodlit pitch
- Directly accessible changing, staff and hospitality space
- Dedicated PE teaching space

Drama

- Integrated drama department in one part of the school site
- Replacement drama studio in extension to current St Cecilia's drama block
- Range of break-out spaces for devised work and rehearsals
- Direct link from new studio to main theatre space







Proposed All Weather Pitch

Key features:

- Significant benefits for participation and involvement in sport, for young people at the school and in the wider community
- Allows all year round use of the pitch
- Will allow the school to address current issues with PE provision and offer an improved PE experience for all pupils
- Will allow the additional of hockey and tennis to the school sport curriculum
- Expands potential sporting facilities for the local community in a sustainable and established location
- Will improve access to, and experience of, sport for generations of pupils at the school

Design to minimise impact:


- New artificial pitch kept close to the school buildings, to reduce potential impact on neighbouring properties
- Changing rooms and car park close to the pitch, to minimise movement around the site
- Located on the site of an existing school pitch maintaining existing patterns of use
- Design makes use of the natural slope and retaining walls to screen the pitch – which will contain sound and minimise impact of floodlights
- Acoustic controls including resilient rebound boards and controlled hours of use
- Focused, dimmable LED floodlights will concentrate light only on the pitch surface


Existing St Cecilia's Ground Floor Plan



Proposed Ground Floor Plan - St. Cecilia's Extension




