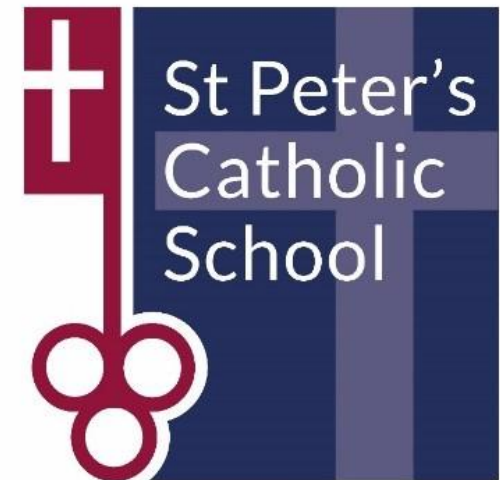
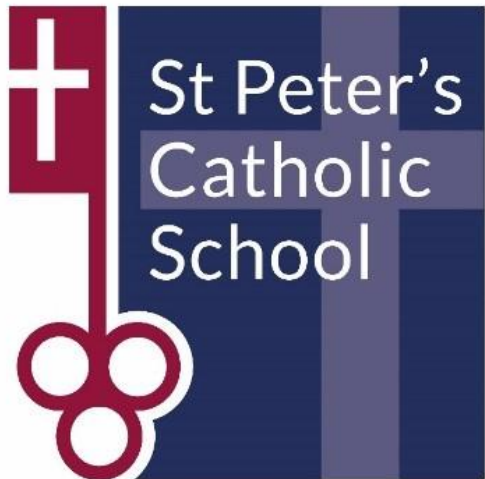


# Extra-curricular clubs

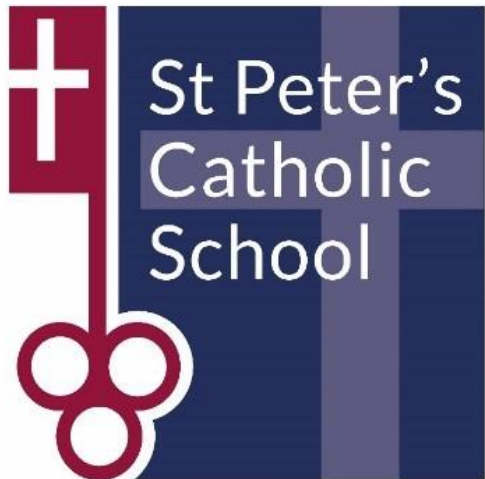

What will I be doing at this club?:

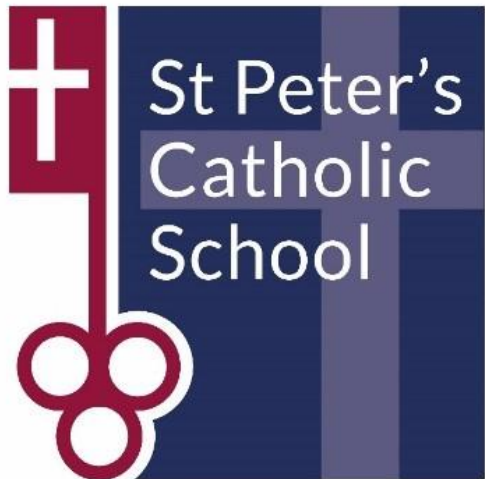
- Learning specialist stagecraft skills such as those used in film/tv/event creation.
