SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

General:

- All students must wear blazers with the school embroidered logo.
- During the cold months, all students must wear a warm, waterproof coat that is plain black, dark grey or navy blue (no logos or hoodies and minimal fur trim).
- Students may only wear a short plain black or navy blue scarf (no logos).
- Students may only wear the specified PE kit for all school sport and extra-curricular activities.
- Students may wear dark coloured knee length or ankle socks. Trainer socks which sit below the ankle and over the knee socks are not permitted.
- No jewellery is permitted except a discreet religious medal on a short chain and a watch.
- Small gold, silver, diamante or pearl studs may be worn as a pair, one in each ear lobe.
- Single earrings are not permitted.
- No jewellery is permitted during PE lessons.
- Pierced ears may not be covered with plasters.
- No extreme hairstyles or colours. The school reserves the right to decide what constitutes 'extreme'.
- No nail varnish, false nails or false eye lashes are permitted.
- Trainers are not allowed other than in PE.
- No visible under-garments.

Boys:

- Shirt collars must be buttoned-up to the top.
- Ties to be done-up correctly and must be worn to the navel.
- Formal black trousers to be worn on the waist with a plain dark belt if required.
- Boys are to be clean-shaven.

Girls:

- The black Rosedale mock kilt must be knee length and the waistband worn on the hips.
- Formal black trousers can be worn as an alternative to the Rosedale mock kilt.
- No cosmetics are permitted in Key Stage 3, although modest cosmetics are allowed in Key Stage 4 at the discretion of the Head of Year.

Sixth Formers:

- Sixth Formers are not required to wear uniform but are expected to be clean, tidy and come dressed in a manner that reflects the ethic of a working day and the school ethos.
